

Are you a committed cat-lover? Would you love an opportunity to provide love and care to cats and kittens as they await their forever homes? If this sounds like you, and if you have some extra space in your heart and in your home, we have just the role for you!

Objective: Provide foster care for cats and kittens as they search for their forever homes.

Responsibilities:

- Provide foster care for cats and/or kittens
- Evaluate animals' personalities and provide information about "ideal" home environment
- Transport foster animals to:
 - Meet & greet or adoption appointments at HEA's Green Bay Adoption Center
 - Vet appointments, if/when applicable
- Communicate regularly with the Foster Coordination Team to:
 - Report any concerns with the animals' behavior and/or health
 - Provide photos and updates for the animals' biography, as needed
- Present a professional appearance as an HEA representative when meeting potential adopters for appointments
- On occasion, administer medications and/or provide care for minor illness

Qualifications:

- Understanding of and/or willingness to learn about cat behavior and health
- Excellent communication skills
- Willingness and ability to provide a foster home for multiple animals throughout the year
- Space for a crate, litterbox, and other supplies, or a separate, "foster only" room in your home.

Reports to: HEA Foster Team

Commitment: Fosters are a vital piece of the animal welfare equation. We are looking for volunteers who are committed to fostering on an ongoing basis (with the opportunity to take "foster breaks" as needed). Some foster cats will move in and out of HEA's care relatively quickly, and others may need a little more time. The exact time commitment will vary from animal to animal.
