Responsibilities include:

- Prepare cottages for guest use including, but not limited to:
 - Stocking cottage(s) with appropriate supplies and informational materials
 - Ensuring the cottage is clean, beds are made, etc.
 - Ensuring that a crate is available and clean for the animal(s)
- Conduct appropriate animal-related preparations to include:
 - Basic grooming, when applicable
 - Assembling overnight bags for the animal(s)
- Follow the outlined check-in process, including:
 - Meeting guests at cottages
 - Providing guests with keys and welcome materials
 - Introducing guests to the animal and answering questions
- Launder all linens for the cottages

Requirements:

- Experience and comfort interacting with cats and/or dogs of varying temperament and size; OR has the desire, confidence, and patience to learn these skills
- Communicates well and collaborates effectively with others
- Well-versed in customer service
- Highly detail oriented
- Has some flexibility in schedule
